

Important: Krew Information



PREPARATION FOR THE JOB

- Make sure you have a good understanding of who is on your team. Be aware things can change at any time before the jobs, so look out for any changes there may be.
- Make sure you have a good understanding of where the krew camp is on site. [Click here](#) to view.
- Bring refillable water bottle
- It can be a good idea to read the 'Rules & Expectations' again before the job starts. [Click here](#).
- If you are new and getting your Krown krew kit on the job, then make sure you are wearing black work pants / jeans or shorts. Plain black, no logos.

ARRIVAL ON THE JOB

- Arrive at least 10 minutes early at the krew camp.
- Contact your Krew Chief in good time should there be any issues.
- Check-in on the app and Krew in-person at the krew camp.
- If you need kit and/or safety shoes they will be there for you at the krew camp when you check-in.

DURING THE JOB

- Help each other out. Make sure to assist less experienced and skilled krew.
- Stick with your team during the job! Do not mix teams unless it is requested by the client. The teams have been setup the way they have for a reason. If unsure, ask your Krew Chief for assistance.
- If smaller groups are needed to be made within a team to complete tasks. Split the teams so that there is at least 1 Prospect, Experienced or Legend for every 2-4 general krew members.
- Only speak English or Danish when working on site.
- If you need assistance, have any questions or anything else, then make contact with your krew chief.
- Make sure to be wearing safety shoes & Krown Krew kit.
- Anyone not following the 'Rules & Expectations' can risk being removed from the job.

AFTER THE JOB

- Return to krew camp and check-out on the app.
